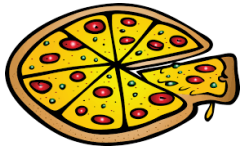
We look forward to seeing our Roger Clap families THIS Thursday, September 30 for our Back to School Night!

- **School Family Council Elections:** Tuesday, October 12 from 6-7pm on Zoom. Learn about how the School Site Council works and elect members of our family community to serve in various leadership roles.

- **Schoolwide Partners (note the change):**

- **Ballet Rox:** Starting on 10/5, K0-Grade 3 students will engage in a weekly dance program.
- **Navigation Games:** Each grade will rotate through a mini fall unit with Navigation Games and Mr. Francois during their PE class. This will include a walking field trip to local parks! Navigation Games gives students the opportunity to engage in collaborative and competitive games around the topic of Orienteering. Orienteering is a racing sport where participants use a map to find a series of checkpoints.
- **Boston Music Project:** Each Thursday, Grade 4-6 students will engage in a weekly instrumental music program. Over the course of the year, students will work with one particular instrument (woodwind or brass) with the expectation to do some performances by the end of the year.
