## **SCHOOL-WIDE UPDATES**

- **COVID-19:** There have been zero cases of the COVID-19 in Boston Public Schools. To ensure this remains true, it is important that we take precautionary measures seriously. Handwashing and hand sanitizer are our first defense. Please see the attached notice with important information about COVID-19.
- Whole School Science Field Trip: The entire Clap school K0-5 will attend a field trip to the Science Museum to make connections to their current science learnings in school and for a visit to the butterfly garden tomorrow, March 11th, 2020. Permission slips have already been sent home, however if you are in need of an extra, one is attached to this newsletter. Signed permission slips must be returned by TOMORROW MORNING, prior to us leaving for the trip. In order for your child to attend, they must be dressed in uniform. We will not be accepting verbal permission slips.

- End of Term 2: Our second term of the school year ends on March 13th, 2020. Students in K0/K1 will receive their first official progress report during the week of March 16th. If your child is absent, please send them in with a note stating why they are out; students with 4 or more unexcused absences will receive all NCs (no credit) on their report card. - **ELA Interim 3:** Next week, students in grades 2-5 will be assessed on their ELA progress this school year using a district-wide assessment. Please be sure your child is well rested so he/she is able to perform his/her best next week on the assessment.
